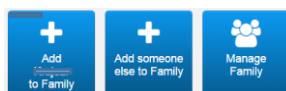

Junior members hire charge at 50% full rate shown for individual items.

Please Note. Club equipment is intended for beginners starting out in fencing and developing into a new weapon. It is the club's expectation that you will purchase your own equipment in a timely manner so that the next round of beginners can benefit as you have. We can advise you in the purchase of your own equipment.
